Thursday June 3^d

These 24 hours strong breezes and cloudy first part bearing ESE at 5 PM St SE wind SNE latter part at SESE and sail in sight

Friday June 4th

The first part at SE by E middle part have no latter part at SE to ESE at 10 AM Sails bearing SE by S in compass Dist 12 miles at 12 M off Saint Helena 1 sail in sight so ends

Saturday June 5th

The first part strong breezes from the N wind spoke Barker Winthrop 8 months 35 bbls Maria 31 months 43 bbls latter part steading in for St Cruz at 10 went on shore with one bbl oil so ends

Sunday June 6th

The first part laying off and on St Cruz at 5 PM got on board with 12 bushels Potatoes 1000 Onions 10 Doz Eggs and 4 Portogues middle part light airs heading off shore at 6 AM landed and got 2 Black fish latter part light airs and calm saw a number of Fin backs so ends

Shores bearing NW 18 miles Dist

Monday June 7th

The first part light airs and calm saw a Whale Brig latter part part light breeze from the NW heading in for the land hauling Black fish Brig in sight so ends

Sat 39.14 Long 31.1

Tuesday June 8th

The first part heading in shore at 4 PM lashed off the land 7 miles Dist middle part short sail at 7 PM wind shifted to the NNE St ESE under double reefed top sail so ends

Sat 38.59 Long 30.1

Wednesday June 9th

The first part blowing fresh from NNE St SE middle have to latter part at ESE saw a Whaling schooner so ends

Sat 36.30 Long 29.20

Thursday June 10th

The first part St by the Wind to the Eward at 4 PM saw Fregal middle part heading off latter part heading in shore at 1 PM Fregal ESE Dist 12 miles so ends

Sat 38.38

Friday June 11th

These 24 hours blowing strong and ragged from the NNE to NNE with squalls of rain at 10 M more ship heading to the Nward latter part at N by N 3 sails so ends

Sat 37.52 Long 30.35

Saturday June 12th

The first part strong breezes NNE by S middle St NNE latter part light airs from the Eward St N saw one Fin back so ends

Sat 37.24 Long 31.54

Sunday June 13th

The first part light airs from the Eward St middle part calm latter part light airs from the ESE St N by S saw 2 fin backs so ends

Sat 37.16 Long 32.37

Monday June 14th

These 24 hours light airs and calm nothing seen so ends

Sat 36.45 Long 33.1

Tuesday June 15th

The first part calm at 1 PM light breezes from the NNE heading to the SNE nothing seen one sail in sight so ends these 24 hours

Sat 36.19 Long 34.1

Wednesday June 16th

The first moderate breeze from the NNE spoke Bark Kathleen Allen Clean 8 weeks and the Mark got 4 See No 1 one backstear 7 latter more one latter part heading NNE

Sat 37.13 Long 33.10

Thursday June 17th

These 24 hours moderate breezes from the Nward St NNE by E middle part short sail saw 2 fin backs 4 sail
