

Friday July 30th
The first part strong breezes spoke Bark George
Washington got 2 letters at 9 pm finished hauling
head latter part boiling lean 5 whale men in sight
Sagal bearing ENE Dist 12 miles

Saturday July 31st
The first part light winds from the NE
middle and latter part the same 6 whale
ships and Barks in sight so ends

Sunday August 1st
The first part moderate breezes and passing
clouds middle and latter part the same
at 10 saw a Bark to windward chasing
Whales could not get near enough to land
the Bark got one whale so ends
3 Barks in sight
Sagal bearing SE Dist
20 miles

Monday August 2nd
These 24 hours strong breezes from the N varying
off Sagal 3 sail in sight spoke Bark Endeavor
our 150 bbls landed in so ends
Lat 38.40 Long 29.10

Tuesday Aug 3rd
The first part strong breezes from the N
middle part moderate latter strong breezes
and squally heading ENE

Lat 39.00 Long 28.45
Wednesday August 4th
These 24 hours strong breezes and squally
blowing off Sagal 2 sail in sight so ends
Lat 39.00 Long 29.00

Thursday August 5th
The first part strong breezes and squally
middle part the same latter part strong
breezes and rugged

Friday Aug 6th
The first part strong breezes from the N
middle part more moderate no whales seen
3 sail so ends

Lat 38.27 Long 29.15
Saturday 7th
The first part moderate breezes from the NW
middle part the same latter part strong
breezes and squally jib stay parted
4 sail in sight
Lat 38.40 Long 29.00

Sunday the 8th
The first part strong breezes and squally
spoke Bark Helen Augusta of Fishery 60 bbls
landed got a letter from E middle part squally
latter part strong breezes spoke Bark Isabella
100 bbls so ends
Sagal bearing SE Dist 10 miles

Monday the 9th
The first part fresh breezes at 6 AM wind shifted
to the NNE and moderate light breezes and
clear 2 sail in sight so ends
Sagal bore ESE Dist 10 miles

Tuesday the 10th
The first part light airs and calm
picked up a stick of timber 40 feet long 2 1/2 feet
square swarmed with latter part wind NW
3 sail in sight employed coopers on bill so ends
Lat 28.15 Long 29.20

Wednesday 11th
The first part strong breezes from the NW
middle part the same latter part wind
NW 6 sail seen so ends
Lat 28.15 Long 29.15

Thursday 12th
The first part strong breezes from the NW middle
moderate latter part light airs 5 sail in sight
Lat 28.25 Long 29.10

Friday 13th
The first part calm middle part light air from the
NW latter part wind NW fine weather
no whales plenty of ships so ends
Lat 28.35 Long 28.50
