The first calm all ready for sea at 2 P.M. light
airs from the N.W. at 6 P.M. and anchor and stand
out to sea middle part light breezes latter part
about calm employed hauling Anchors &c &c ended
at 12 M the Wind bearing N.E. dist 15 miles

7 sail in sight

Monday August 30/54

The first part calm middle part the same latter
part light airs from the N at 9 A.M. saw a
bark chasing Whales lured our boats so we
the Wind bearing S.E. 12 miles dist

11 sail in sight

Tuesday August 31st

The first part calm at 2 P.M. light airs from
the E.S. to S.E. at 3 P.M. boats got on
board saw ships chasing Whales to the South
of us at 4 P.M. saw 3 large
Whales lured for one up them he was going
to quitch 7 sail in sight 8 of them had
been chasing Whales but did not get any
saw the Clever sailing

latter part light variable winds &c ended

Wednesday Sept 1st/54

The first part moderate breezes from the S middle
part the same latter strong breezes from the W.W. &
spoke Bark Atlantic late 140 hble this morn
Fogal bearing E.N.E. Dis 15 miles &c ended

Thursday Sept 2nd

The first part moderate at 2 P.M. light airs from the
N middle part calm latter part light airs from
N.W. heading to the N 3 sail in sight

Lat 38.10 Long 29.11

Friday 3rd

The first and middle part light airs from the N.W. with
a heavy swell latter part light breeze from the W. main
7 sail in sight
