to the S middle part moderate latter part blowing
fresh from the NW heading off SW so ends
Fin backs No obs Lat 39.19 Long 45.46

Saturday Dec 4th

The first part blowing a gale from the off ward
and squally at 6 PM cleared off and moderated
latter part fine weather plenty of Fin backs
Lat 40.07 Long 45.45
Sea 45.52 more off

Sunday Dec 5th

The first breeze on from the N head to the off ward
middle part standing whole watches varying sail
latter part fine squalls plenty of Fin backs
2 hump backs Lat 40.53 Long 45.45
47.45

Monday Dec 6th

The first part strong breezes from the off ward
foggy at 9 PM more ship head to the N wind off
latter part calm and clear many Fin backs
Lat 40.53 Long 46.16
Sea 48.12

Tuesday Dec 7th

The first part moderate breezes from the off ward
by the wind to the off ward middle part short sail
boats creep watches latter light airs and calm with
fine squalls many patches of blue water fall of
Jelly so ends

The first part moderate breezes from the off heading
middle and latter part light airs and calm ends
middle the wind at S squalls
among Fin backs

to the E latter part off NNE many Fin
backs so ends
