Friday March 23rd

The first part moderate breeze from the S and E
heading N N W to N N E middle part heading
N N E latter part heading N strong breezes
finished setting up shrouds

Lat 24.10 Long 6.29

Saturday March 24th

These 24 strong breezes from E by S to E S E
by the wind to the N and E latter part
employed washing ship.

Lat 22.14 Long 6.18

Sunday March 25th

These 24 hours strong breezes and squally course
N E by E heading N E to N E by E

Lat 20.15 Long 5.34

Monday March 26th

These 24 hours strong trades and squally course
N E by N match employed on the rigging and sail
in sight at bearing N by N $\frac{1}{2}$ W Dist 7 miles

Lat 17.20 Long 5.03

Tuesday March 27th

The first part strong breezes at N E by N at 6 AM
N by E shrouds set at 11 luffed to the wind at 5 PM
at 6 AM saw the land bearing N W by W at 11 PM
it got the anchors off the bows bent the chains
sent up sky sail poles go at the land 15 miles Dist
se ends 8 men with the scurvy others complaining

Wednesday March 28th

The first part light airs at 9 AM came to anchor
in 25 fathoms water
