June 1/53

These 24 hours blowing a moderate gale from the ESE and SE none to latter part clearing the sheet &c

Sat 37.41 Sany 45.21

Thursday June 2nd

The first part blowing fresh from the SE heading to the ESE finished the sheet and Varished it latter part rather more moderate made sail same one Fin back 2 sail

Sat 38.48 Sany 44.54

Friday June 3rd

These 24 hours strong breezes from the SE to SSE middle part heading to the SW latter to the E made saw one Fin back empty in ships duty

Sat 39.29 Sany 44.04

Saturday June 4th

The first part strong breezes from the S heading ESE saw delphian bottoms and Grampises & porpoises middle short sail latter part heading SE strong breezes and cloudy

No Obs Sat 39.25 Sany 43.

Sunday June 5th

The first part strong breezes and rainy heading SE middle under double reefed top sails latter part heading SE by S strong breezes and rough one ship in sight

Obs Sat 39.29 Sany 40.15

Monday June 6th

These 24 hours blowing a moderate gale from the SE middle part none to latter part under double reefed main close reefed fore top sails & fore sail heading the SSE 134 Points variation

Sat 38.58 Sany 38.26

Robert Bruce was taken sick this day

Cruising in the North Atlantic

Tuesday June 7/53

The first part blowing a moderate gale from the SE middle rather more moderate wind shifted to the NW at 6 AM shifted sudden to ESE blowing fresh and regular saw Grampises

Sat 38.46 Sany 37.33

Wednesday June 8th

The first part strong breezes from the ESE heading to the SE passed a bark 11 to the W and middle short sail latter part light breezes heading NNE at 6 PM saw a hump back sound

Sat 38.23 Sany 36.47

Thursday June 9th

These 24 hours light airs and calm saw Grampises Porpoises & Fin backs 2 sails

Sat 39.15 Sany 36.55

Friday June 10th

These 24 hours light airs and calm Fin Backs and Porpoises saw several sail one from the watch employed on the rigging

Sat 39.08 Sany 36.40

Saturday June 11th

The first part light airs from the NE middle light wind from the N to the ESE short sail latter part fine weather 3 sail in sight

Sat 39.55 Sany 35.39

Sunday June 12

These 24 hours light breezes from the N.W. fine weather SE SE and E see a number of Fin backs spoke Brig James Gray of Newbury Port bound to Richmond Virginia for Long 81 miles to W of our chronometer

Sat 40.00 Sany 34.20 Sany 33.55
