Monday June 13/53

The steam These 24 hours light airs around the compass told me saw a number of Fin backs & sails that one of the boatmen saw

My boat threatened to knife him about 1st

The yesterday did not tell me because

it was Sunday. O dear

Tuesday June 14th

The first part light breezes from the NW at SE middle part about calm latter part light airs from the SE at SE by E at noon saw the tail of Flores bearing SE & E

Wednesday June 15th

The first part light airs from the NW at by the wind at 6 PM Flores bore SE dist 29 miles middle part heading off and on latter part came for Black Point Delgada bearing SSE dist 15 miles

so ends

Thursday June 16th

The first part light airs at for Point Delgada saw spoke to the NW kept off for them did not see them again middle heading off and on latter part at for at track see on ship laying off and on Robert Bruce very low at 12 M dist 15 miles off

so ends

Friday June 17th

The first part light baffling winds could not get in near enough to go on shore at 8 PM came at 9 PM Bruce breathed his last middle part under short sail heading to the S latter part heading to the S and NW at NW 2 hours at 11 AM buried R Bruce 4 different whale resellers then 24 hours 1 merchant vessel.

Saturday June 18th

The first part at by the wind to the NW at 4 PM at SE by S Flores in sight dist 30 miles middle part light airs at SE all sail out latter part at SE and by the wind on Fajal employed smoking ship to kill bats and sail

Sunday June 19th

The first light airs from the NW with light showers at 4 PM opened the ship found 18 bats dead middle part short sail latter part equally SE and SE saw Fin backs

Monday June 20th

The first light squalls of wind and rain SE by E for Fajal at 6 PM bearing SE by E dist 18 miles spoke Spoke Greyhound 6.00 M latter part light breezes from the SE at 12 M Fajal bearing SE dist 10 miles

so ends

Tuesday June 21st

The first part light airs heading to the N middle part and latter calm at 12 M light airs from the NW Fajal Wind bearing S dist 8 miles

so ends these 24

Wednesday June 22nd

The first part light breezes from the NW SE by the wind to the NW saw one Fin back and school of Grampuses middle part about calm latter part breezes at 5 Fajal Wind bearing S dist 8 miles SE at 12 M off the Wind of SE George

so ends

The first part at by S at 7 PM the SE end of Graciosa bore NW by E dist 8 miles middle part short sail light airs and calm at 8 AM strong breezes from NW at 12 M off Secura Town of Angra

so ends

The first part at round the SE end of Secura at 9 PM the Port of Angra bearing NW by N dist 10 miles middle part heading off and on latter part equally at 12 M went on shore at P Braya
