Monday July 25/53

The first part calm middle part the same
at 2 P.M. light airs from the N.W. ward at 8 A.M.
between Jacirca and St George at 12 M
blowing fresh from the N.W. see Grampises

The first part S.E. by E blowing fresh from the
N.W. at 8 P.M. off the S.E. Point Jacirca latter
part blowing fresh and squally at 10 M. Port Praya
have N.W. dist 12 miles see a school of sperm
whales found for them struck one to each boat
at 12 M 3 whales seen so early

Wednesday July 27th

The first part blowing fresh from the N.W. at
3 P.M. got the whales along side cut 2 in
middle moderate latter part about calm at 11
finished cutting at 11 by E light air employed
clearing away heads at 12 M Port Praya have
N.W. dist 16 miles

Thursday July 28th

The first part light airs from the South began
to hail middle part heading to the E.S. latter
part wind E.S. thick light showers rain employed
boiling passed a big so early

No obs Jacirca bearing N.W. dist 25 miles

Friday July 29th

The first part sun out and cloudy heading shore
middle bearing off latter part fine weather employed
boiling at 10 M the sun bearing N.W. dist 17 miles

Saturday July 30

The first part light airs from the S.W. ward
middle part the same at 8 P.M. finished boiling
latter part light airs from the E.S. heading
to the South at 11 locked to the N.E. Jacirca
St George Rio and St Michaels in sight
