Tuesday Aug 9th

The first part calm lower for grasspawes could not get near enough to strike at 11 AM to a light breeze from the South heading to the off near latter part heading to the ESE nothing seen

Lat 37.35 Long 26.15

Wednesday Aug 10

The first wind S by SSE squalls of rain middle moderate latter fine breeze from NE heading ESE at 11 AM 2 1/2 miles dist

so ends

Thursday Aug 11

The first part wind NE at 9 AM close in to the off of St Marys middle part short sail latter part beaten under St Marys 5 merchant men seen

so ends

Friday Aug 12th

The first part moderate breezes from the NE heading to the NW middle short sail latter part wind from the N heading to the off are sail seen

Lat 36.55 Long 25.25

Saturday Aug 13

The first part at 10 AM the wind heading N by E middle part light airs all sail set heading N by E at 3 AM at E at 4 off the SE end of St Michaels latter part heading to the NNE one sail seen

Lat 37.55 Long 25.45

Sunday Aug 14

The first light breezes from the W and WNW at 10 AM the wind to the N middle part calm latter part light airs from the WNW and W heading in shore at 12 the sea part of St Michaels bearing SEW dist 20 miles & whale backs in sight in the bay

so ends

Spoke Bank Sea Flower 20 bells
heard from "Greyhound" 5,000 "
in air - same time

Monday Aug 15th

These 24 hours heading up to St Michaels Bay at 12 AM off Point Beberia Grand 4 miles dist one sail in sight

so ends

Tuesday Aug 16th

The first fresh breezes from NW to WNW in St Michaels Bay nothing seen middle strong breezes and squally heading to the NW latter part blowing fresh and squally from the W heading to the NW and WNW at 9 shortened sail

so ends

Lat 38.38 Long 26.30

Wednesday 17

These 24 hours blowing a moderate gale from the W and squally at 10 by the wind middle part heading to the S

so ends

Lat 38.36 Long 26.31

Thursday Aug 18th

The first part blowing fresh from the W and squally weather middle more moderate latter part light airs from the W showers of rain at 11 Lercira bearing W by N dist 20 miles

No Obs at 28.00 Aug 26.25 so ends

Friday Aug 19th

The first part fine breezes from the N and clear at 5 AM off Port Bryan at 4 off Los Frailes at 10 calm at 12 found the ship was getting rather near the rocks lower one boat turned one hour at 12 AM light airs at off shore latter part a hard calm at 12 Angora bore N by W dist 15 miles

Saturday Aug 20th

The first light breezes from the NW at 10 AM the wind to the NW at 5 AM took a squall from the S heading to the NW at 11 AM Fogal Bay in sight middle under double reef top sails jib and spinnaker heading to the NW latter part light baffling from W to NW heading to get in to St George at 12 the land bearing NNE dist 12 miles so ends
