The first part moderate breezes from the SW
middle the latter from W to NW cruising off
the W end Tantal & sail in sight no whales

Saturday Sept 3rd

The first part light airs from the N heading
W at 3 PM S S E middle part short
sail about noon at 9th took a breeze from
the SW at 10th S S E see the 40 bound home
several sail
do ends

Sunday Sept 4th

The first part small breeze from the SW at
10th S S E middle and latter moderate heading SE
by S and S S E
do ends

Monday Sept 5th

The first part light breezes from the S and W
at 10th by the wind to the S E middle part the
same at 10th daylight a sperm whale came up close
to the ship's bow got the boats ready and lowered
at 9th the lar boat struck him at 9th took him along
side got dark part began to cut at sunset
head off
do ends

These 24 hours light airs from the S at dawn
set head off and by in latter part got the
junk in sailing line at 9 PM began to hoist
spoke Bark Andrews all mellow oil on board

The first fine weather at 3 PM finished sailing
last middle and latter part sailing at Michael
in sight
do ends

cooled down wind shifted to the NW
more ship heading to the SW at 9 began
to hoist latter part began to moderate
rice in sight
do ends

These 24 hours more moderate employed
hoisting one whale big seen
do ends

The first part fine weather finished sailing
turned up 111 bbls of oil on deck spoke
ship Asena Barker all well down

Sunday Sept 11th

The first part strong breezes from the W SW
heading to the S middle part wind shifted to
the S latter part light squalls of rain heading
to the E and nothing seen
do ends

Sat 36.44 Long 26.33

Monday Sept 12th

These 24 hours fresh breezes from S W heading
to the E and latter part strong dam oil
& sail seen the Gal of St Mary's heading N E 100
30 miles
do ends

Tuesday Sept 13th

The first part strong breezes middle and latter
part moderate finished stowing oil nothing seen
