Sat 38.26 Long 29.10

Tuesday Sept 27th

The first part blowing fresh from the S.E. heading to the S.W. middle part raising at 2 A.M. wind & more ship to the E. wind latter part fine weather S.E. East all sail set & sail in sight

Sat 38.14 Long 28.48

Wednesday Sept 28th

The first part light breezes from the S.E. at 5 P.M. lained off shore middle part heading off and on latter part fine weather S.E. for Breeze at 10 A.M. went on shore so ends Ship Louisiana Norton and bark Franklin Sacked begin off and on Brig Harmony & 100 bbls

Thursday Sept 29th

The first part moderate breezes from the S at 2 P.M. came off S. out by the wind to the S.W. middle part light air at 12 lained to the E. wind latter part moderate at 10 lained to the S.W. Dist 12 miles Dist watch at work on the rigging

Friday Sept 30

I found one letter from home and what the reason is I don't know my office and boat stoves got quite a number But men for me I never had but one that made much to me and when she stops I have to go with out I hope she is alive and well but rather uneasy about it - H.

Sept 30 I feel about discouraged I don't know as I have one friend in this world It don't appear as though I had I don't see as it is any use for me to try any longer might as well give it up I have not any thing changed me at all Hope Edward has made some sick

These 24 hours light breezes from S.E. to South S. by the wind stark to the E. wind 1 hour head S.W. by W. and W. by S. employed painting breaking out masts and clearing up between decks

Sat 37.18 Long 26.18

Saturday Oct 1st

The first part moderate breezes from the S.W. S. by the wind to the S.W. middle part the same latter strong breezes finished painting ship met with

Sat 37.16 Long 26.18

Sunday Oct 2nd

The first part moderate breezes from the S.W. S. by the wind to the S.W. middle and latter part the same

Sat 37.16 Long 33.1

Monday Oct 3rd

The first part light wind from the S. at 6 P.M. lained to the S.E. at 9 lained to the W. wind at 6 A.M. wind S.W. to W. wind ship to the South bent new fore sail & fore topmast stay sail light masts

Sat 37.14 Long 33.36

Tuesday Oct 4th

These 24 hours light air from the S. S. to the S. and S. lained the fore yard masts it having been sprung some time did not think it safe sent it to the fore yard fitting another

Sat 36.30 Long 33.45

Wednesday Oct 5th

These 24 hours light air from the S. S. S.W. by South sent up new fore yard bent fore sail latter part painted it set up main top mast rigging repaired main top sail unhooked the main sail all hands employed had some masts with the horse yesterday requested him to have the mast heads mended rather earlier in good weather he was very much vexed about it turned out before daylight this morning say he will turn out at 2 o'clock every morning Sat 36.41 Long 33.55
