jibs and spankers at 8 PM close

The first part strong breezes from the
N.W. at SE heavy swell from the
South coiling lines middle wind

The first fine breezes from the N.W. at
SE middle part the same latter
part fresh breezes saw a spout & fog
to did not see it again so ends

middle and latter part blowing fresh
from the SE at SE under double
reefed top sails and fore sail to reefed
to do much

Tuesday Aug 15th
The first part strong breezes from
the N.W. and squalls at SE
middle part more moderate latter
part light air from the off ward
at SE employed dashing up
spinnaker &c

The first moderate breezes from the
N.W. at SE middle part the same
latter part wind SE sent up the
cutting pendants rose the cutting
falls and &c so ends
I find the ship leaks same
