The first part fresh breezes from the SE heading SE nothing seen middle part moderate latter part squally head to the S and SE E wind from the NW wind

The first part strong breezes from the NW SE and SE heading to the S at 3 PM the jib unbent it bent another double reefed the top sail furlled the midship sail middle part blowing fresh breeze to latter a moderate gale saw Whales going quick to the NW 5 rapid to lower

Friday Nov 17

The first and middle part blowing a gale from the NW latter part more moderate than SE NW saw one Fin back bent main top sail and saw forward condensation 35.19 Long 9.12 and one

Saturday Nov 18

The first SE E. Fair weather, middle and latter part calm Not a Porpoise
