The first part light airs from the NNE at 2 1/2 PM hauled up the boats at 4 PM down for a whale shot a bomb lance in to him and struck him at the same time the lance set him spouting thick blood at 9 PM took the whale along side at 10 PM finished cutting saw one whale to mind saw one ship

Monday Dec 11th

The first part fresh breezes from the North at by the wind saw one whale going quick to mind saw at 8 PM have to beget to North latter part strong breezes from the N spoke Bark Ripple 6.00 whale 1.00 2 sail in sight de coals

Tuesday Dec 12th

The first part fresh breezes from the NW middle part light breeze latter wind & nothing seen latter part sailing

Wednesday Dec 13th

The first part light airs from the E wind 2 sail in sight at 11 PM finished boiling latter part fine weather at 4 PM down for whales shot a lance in to one set him spouting blood got one lance in him at the same time it died out the whale went off several sail seen saw the Comulge at to the E wind

Thursday Dec 14th

The first part light airs from the NNE at 8 spoke Bark Noll Sagharawa nothing this seen middle part at 4 PM all sail set fore top mast at 11 PM latter part several sail seen

Lat 37.08 Long 5.20

Friday Dec 15/54

The first part wind NNE at 4 PM I saw Fin backs middle part all sail set fore top mast at sail in latter part fresh breezes one ship in sight plenty Fin backs started the sail into the tank de coals

Lat 36.50 Long 1.40 West

Sat Friday Dec 16th

The first part fresh breezes from the N at 4 PM down for a whale whale with out success middle part hose to mind from the N wind at 9 PM at 11 PM under double reefed top sails saw one sail de coals

Lat 36.38 Long 2.10 West

Sunday Dec 17th

The first part blowing fresh from the SE at 4 PM middle part under close reefed top sail latter part wind & under single reefes and courses

Lat 36.13 Long 2.38 E

Monday Dec 18th

These 24 hours fresh breezes from the SE at by the wind to the E wind several Fin backs seen one sail

Lat 35.50 Long 4.48 E

Tuesday Dec 19th

The first part strong breezes from the SSE heading to the E wind at 9 PM backed to the SE latter part light airs many Fin backs one sail

Lat 36.18 Long 4.20 E

Wednesday Dec 20th

The first and middle part calm latter part light airs from the off at 8 PM many Fin backs one sail
