Saturday Jan 10th
The first and middle part light air
from the S latter part light wind
from the ENE a number of Fin
backs seen

Sunday Jan 11th
These 24 hours light variable wind
course SE by E several Fin back
seen plumped 309 shakes
" Lat 40.34 Long 58.03

Monday Jan 12th
These 24 hours light air from the South
and E and calm course SE one sail
in sight - Laurel and tried to shoot
a Sulphur bottom but could not get
near enough

Lat 41.31 Long 58.51

Tuesday Jan 13th
The first part light air from the E and
and calm latter part wind from the SE
course SE by E one sail in sight

Lat 41.41 Long 60.13

Wednesday Jan 14th
The first part moderate breeze from the
South heading ESE middle and latter part
heading from ESE to ENE one sail in
sight repairing fore sail

Lat 41.43 Long 62.01

Thursday Jan 15th
The first part fresh breeze from the
E and heading SSE middle and latter
SE

Lat 42.04 Long 63.10

Friday Jan 16th
These 24 hours strong breeze from NNE to
N course SE by E all sail set

Lat 42.36 Long 69.54

Saturday Jan 17th
The first part blowing fresh from the N
at 6 PM took in fly jib & gaff top sail
middle middle blowing a gale from the
NNW latter part under double fore and main
top sails and fore sail at 12 M wind
West whole main top sail

Sunday Jan 18th
The first part blowing fresh from the N and
middle part moderate latter moderate breeze
from the NNE course SE by E

Lat 43.13 Long 78.03

Monday Jan 19th
The first part light air from the NNE
middle and latter blowing fresh and squally
from the NNE and SE by E under present
sail

Lat 43.12 Long 81.20

Tuesday Jan 20th
These 24 hours blowing fresh and squally
course SE by E latter part rather near
moderate

Wednesday Jan 21th
These 24 hours strong breeze from the
N and SE by E

Lat 43.10 Long 90.12

Thursday Jan 22th
These 24 hours wind from NNE to NW
SE by E strong breeze great many
birds
