These 24 hours blowing fresh from the Nward course ESE

Sunday Jan 28th

Commenced with a gale from the NW at 3 PM shifted to W blowing heavy in squalls at 4 PM running under close reefed main top sail and fore sail at 5 PM more moderate made more sail latter wind WNW SE & E

Monday Jan 29th

The first part fresh breezes from WNW and equally latter part wind WSE good weather at ESE

Lat 42.27 Long 108.53

Tuesday Jan 30th

These 24 hours moderate breezes from the WNW first part at SE by E middle and latter part at ESE made a near bucket rope beat it

Wednesday Jan 31st

These 24 hours light breeze and cloudy weather course ESE

Thursday Feb 1st

These 24 hours light breezes first part from the S latter part ENE saw 8 grampuses

The first part light breezes from the NE at SE middle SE E latter part moderate breezes from NNE at 2 PM saw 40 Whales chased for them the last boat got on to one missed him so ends chase
