The first part strong breezes from the
N and squally middle part the same
latter part squally wind from NW to
N heading to the N and E

Friday Feb 23rd
These 24 hours strong breezes and squally
from N and W course NNE

Lat 37.05 Long 163.30

Saturday Feb 24th
The first part light airs from
the NW St NNE middle part
wind from the W latter part
SE St NE by N to N

Sunday Feb 25th
The first and middle part fresh breezes from
the S St NE latter part blowing fresh from
the SE and squally at 10 came the three
kings bearing NE 1/2 N dist 15 miles at 12
close to us saw 2 sail

Monday Feb 26

The first part strong breezes from the SSE
St E by S at 4 PM heading E at 9 PM off
the N Cape of New Zealand middle bearing
ESE at 4 AM backed to the SW at 7 AM backed
to the SE at 12 M heading SE blowing fresh
and squally saw 2 sail Manganawa
bearing SSW dist 20 miles

Tuesday Feb 27th

The first part strong breezes from the SW
at 4 PM close in to Knuckle Point middle
part moderate lay of the mouth of the Bay
latter part blowing fresh and squally from
the S at 9 AM came to Anchor off Munga
new harbours at ends washing ship
ships King Fisher and Omega ready
for sea

Wednesday 28th

This day blowing fresh from the SE and
raining latter part watch on liberty to bad
weather to do anything on board so ends

Thursday 29th March 1/54

The first part strong breezes from the ESE
and squally got under way and beat in between
the heads and came to Anchor latter part
blowing fresh and squally watch on
liberty watch on board caplay breaking
out look and heaving them

so ends

Friday March 30th

The first part fresh breezes and squally
blowing to fresh to get a sight of water
latter part blowing fresh from the E painting
and getting water watch on board

Saturday March 31st

The first part blowing fresh ships provisions
arrived clean slopping water and painting
watch on liberty latter part the
same

so ends
