so ends

Wednesday 11 Thursday July 12th
The first part light wind and thick weather
spoke back Alice Call spring 1 Dead
Whale latter part fresh breeze and
Fog from the SE beating to windward
task as occasion required so ends
downed lot in light

Thursday 12 Friday July 13
These 24 hours thick and rainy strong
breezes and moderate beating to the south
at 10 AM saw 2 ships hailing
saw an house her boats down
so ends
