Thursday 26 Friday July 27th 1855
The first part light winds chasing
Whales and hailing latter part the M boat
struck a whale at 11 AM took him along
side clearing away to cut
so ends

Friday 27th Saturday 28th
The first part cutting in at 7 finished
latter part hailing later came in the
fog took the boat up hailing and slowing
down
so ends

Sat 28th Sunday 29th
The first part thick at 6 PM cleared off
at 8 hours one boat with out success latter
part blowing a gale from the SE off here
to hailing
so ends

Sunday 29 Monday July 30
These 24 hours thick weather and fresh
winds from the SE off here to hailing
and setting up shovels etc
so ends

Monday 30th Tuesday July 31st
The first part blowing fresh from the
SE off and foggy at 6 PM made the land
found one had got to the N made sail
to hold on at 6 AM blowed on horse to
so ends

Tuesday 31st Wednesday July August 1st
The first part blowing fresh from the SE
middle part more moderate latter part
light air from the N at 11 AM at 2 PM
finished cutting 4 ships
so ends

Wednesday August 1st Thursday Aug 2nd
The first part calm latter part light air
and foggy employed slowing down till
spoke ship found 1100 bbls 6 ships in sight
so ends

Thursday Aug 2nd Friday Aug 3rd 1855
The first part light air and calm latter
part the same chasing Whales with out
success
so ends

Friday 3 Saturday Aug 4th
The first light breeze from the N
at 11 in for the SE at 7 AM sent
a boat on shore to see if we could
get water at 8 came off at 9 AM sent
a raft on shore light air and calm
scrapping and drying home
so ends

Sat 3rd 1855

Sat 4 Sunday Aug 5th
The first light air and calm at 4 PM
got the raft of water off latter part
fresh breeze from the NNE saw
a shark got a whale to mind over
3 ships Bailing
so ends

Sunday 5th Monday Aug 6th
The first part blowing fresh from the
NNE at 2 PM later for Whales
the Bon Boat struck and cut from
the whale at 9 PM got on board
latter part calm lower with out success
so ends

Monday 6 Tuesday Aug 7th
The first light air and calm at 4 PM
Bon Boat struck a whale got him
a long side at 12 PM finished cutting
got one boat a head to bow ship off shore
latter part light air 2 boat chasing
Whales drying home etc
so ends

Tuesday 7 Wednesday Aug 8th
The first part light breeze from the
NNE the boat got a whale at 6 PM
him along side at 2 PM finished
cutting sent all hands below at 4 AM
clearing the deck started the mokes etc
so ends
