The first part light airs and variable at 3 P M took over Anchor and set out between Bransi and Zakaarawa middle part light airs and calm latter part light wind from the NNE at 4 P M changed the anchors and chains at 12 M Zakaarawa bearing ENE dis 4 miles course S by E with moderate trades

Saturday Dec 15th

The first part moderate breezes from the Eward bearing S by E at 8 AM took a light breeze from the SE heading to the S and E at 9 AM wind SE heading SE at 12 M heading SE fresh breezes employed swabbing the boats &c

Lat 17.15 Long 157.18

Sunday Dec 16th

The first part part strong trades at 10 AM the wind heading S by E took in top gallant sails middle part heading SE to S latter part all sail set

Lat 17.14 Long 157.22

Monday Dec 17th

These 24 hours strong breezes from the E to ESE at 10 AM wind to the S under prudent sail painting Boats &c

Lat 15.07 Long 157.25

Tuesday Dec 18th

These 24 hours fresh breezes and squally carrying all prudent sail at SSE employed in various jobs fitting boats &c
