July Sunday 26th
This day begins with light winds from the N steering SNE the middle part light winds from the N the latter part strong winds from the NNE ship on the larboard tack three sails in sight spoke one of them the *Valetta* of Boston Bound to *Valparaiso* so ends the day

This day begins with strong winds and increasing from the NNE ship on the larboard tack the latter part light gale from the N so ends the day

Tuesday 28th
This day begins with strong winds from the NNE ship on the larboard tack the latter part winds strong and thick weather from the NNE course NNE by N nothing in sight so ends the day

This day begins with a moderate breeze from the N ship on the larboard tack the middle part calm latter part light breeze from the NNE steering SNE nothing in sight so ends the day

This day begins with light winds from the NNE steering SNE
The middle part calm the latter part strong breeze from the SSB nothing in sight so ends the day

This day begins with strong winds from the SSW steering SNE one sail in sight the main top gallant chain plate parted fitted it and set the stay up again the latter part strong breeze from SNE steering NNE one sail in sight steering to the north and eastward so ends this last day of July
