August

Sunday 16th

This day begins with a fine breeze
from the W. S. W. steering N. by E.
And this day ends as it begins
a small thin back so ends the day
Lat 30:00 S
Long 29:48 W

Monday 17th

This day begins with fine weather
and a light breeze from the W. S. W.
steering N. the middle part calm
the latter part a fine breeze
from the S. W. steering N. by E. two
sails in sight one being steering
to the north sent the fore
top gallant mast and yard aloft
and set the fore top gallant sail
so ends the day Lat 27:48
Long 30:00

Tuesday 18th

This day begins with a fine breeze
from the S. W. steering N. by E. the
middle and latter part the same
sent fore royal aloft 3 sails in sight
two of them working to the south
ward one steering to the northward
so ends the day Lat 26:18
Long 30:00

Wednesday 19th

This day begins with light breeze
from the S. steering N. by E. the latter
part wind hauled to the W. S. W.
steering N. by E. one sail in sight
steering the same
Lat 25:20 S
Long 30:10 W

Thursday 20th

This day begins with light winds
from the W. S. W. steering N. by E.
the middle part wind hauled to the
S. the latter part wind hauled
to the W. steering N. by E. one
sail in sight so ends the day
Lat 23:30 S
Long 29:45 W

Friday 21st

This day begins with light winds
from the W. steering N. by E.
the latter part wind hauled
to the S. steering N. by E.
nothing in sight so ends the day
Lat 21:05 S
Long 29:46 W

Saturday 22nd

This day begins with light winds from
the S. at 4 P. M. saw land the
Island of Ispiradad bearing E about
thirty miles off the latter
part wind a baffling from
the eastward one sail in sight
so ends the day Lat 18:42 S
Long 30:24 W

Sunday 23rd

This day begins with light and a light
breeze from the eastward the latter
part strong and windy and squally
from the E. course so ends the day
Lat 16:19 S
Long 31:20 W
