July

Friday 22^d
This day strong breeze from W S W ship on the star tack this day took the galley to pieces and cleaned most of the things at 7 P M got supper cant Dolphin

Saturday 23^d
This day strong breeze from the W S W ship on the star tack under double reefed top sails finished fitting the galley

Sunday 24th
This day strong breeze from W S W ship on the star tack at 1 P M set the shrouk the reefs out of main topsail 3 three sails in sight at 7 P M took in sail

Monday 25th
This day fine breeze from W S W ship on the star tack nothing in sight caught Porpoise

Tuesday 26th
This day strong breeze from W S W at 11 A M saw White Water on the Sea Beam 5 miles off at 5 P M saw Whale one rising did not lower

Wednesday 27th
This day began with strong winds from W S W and ends with light winds from the same nothing in sight at 7 P M took in sail

Thursday 28th
This day light air from W S W at 6 A M saw Black fish leaved and did not catch again broke out the fore hall to see shrouk at 7 P M got supper with the Watch

This day light winds from N W saw gumpers 2 two sails in sight at 7 P M took in sail

Saturday 30th
This day strong breeze from N W ship on the star tack two sails in sight washing ship at 7 P M took in sail

Sunday 31st
This day light breeze from N E steering W and N by S one sail in sight at 7 P M took in sail

August Monday 1st
This day light winds from N W to W S W ship on the starboard tack set the starboard main rigging up and main topsail back stays at 7 P M took in sail caught fish

Tuesday 2^d
This day strong breeze from N E steering South and Westward one sail in sight at 7 P M took in sail

Wednesday 3^d
This day fine breeze from N and E Ward broke out water caught fish nothing in sight at 7 P M took in sail

Thursday 4th
This day light breeze from W S W to N E ship on the star tack at 7 P M wore ship nothing in sight at 7 P M took in sail
