

Remarks On Board Ship Hooper
August

Monday 15

This day light breeze from S S E ship on star tack 5 fine or more sails in sight no fish at 7 P M took in sail so ends this day

Tuesday 16th

This day light breeze from W S W ship on starboard tack latter part saw breaches at 6 P M saw spouts & heard a long way off 7 sails in sight two whales at 7 P M took in sail

Wednesday 17th

This day strong breeze from W S W 7 sails in sight more or less saw several jumpers at 7 P M took in sail so ends

Thursday 18th

This day begins with strong winds from W ship under double reefed topsails latter part light gale from E ship under short sail one sail in sight weather squally & raining

Friday 19th

This day light gale from E ship on star tack at 11 A M rose ship one sail in sight saw a flying fish wings at 7 P M took in sail

Saturday 20th

This day begins with strong winds from E latter part moderated made all sail one sail in sight at 7 P M took in sail

Cruising North Atlantic

Sunday 21st

This day light breeze from E N E ship on the star tack all A M saw Blackfish lowered got none at 4 P M rose ship steering S S E at 7 P M took in sail

Monday 22nd Long

This day fine breeze from N N W steering S S S W at 10 A M saw Blackfish lowered Lar Boat got none very shy at 7 P M took in sail 3 sails

Tuesday 23rd

This day strong breeze from the North ship on star tack two sails in sight sent the main top gallant sail on deck and repaired it sent it again at 7 P M took in sail so ends the day

Wednesday 24

This day strong breeze from N E ship on the starboard tack broke out water one sail in sight at 7 P M took in sail

Thursday 25th

This day begins with light breeze from E N E mid part calm latter part squally from N N W set the flying jib guys and fore top gallant backstays up at 7 P M took in sail

Friday 26

This day fine breeze from N N W to N N E at 7 A M rose spouts to leeward called them sperm whales lowered but they were killers let them go at 7 P M took in sail
