 Remarks on board the Ship *Jamaica*  
 Wednesday June the 19<sup>th</sup> 1867  
 First part in flying blowing up the  
 Ship aheading. At 10 under Double reefed  
 top sail & for sail & min sail saw  
 nothing at sunset wore to the South  
 top sail & full & the for sail & min sail  
 Middle part. At weather at Daylight  
 commenced repairing the min sail  
 by daylight sail at 9 AM saw the Ship  
 Milton at 11 AM Capt came on board  
 & finished the min sail & gallant sail  
 so ind the Day

Thursday June the 20<sup>th</sup>  
 First part commenced braking out  
 for small stores still we in  
 company with Milton at 4 PM finished  
 braking out at sunset wore Ship to  
 the South & took in the sail still  
 the Capt on board Middle part  
 moderate weather at Daylight set min  
 sail & full still under Double  
 reefed top sail & full for sail &  
 min sail with fresh breeze from the  
 W the Ship heading South still the  
 Capt of the Milton on board so  
 ind the Day

Friday June the 21<sup>st</sup>  
 First part fresh breeze & squalls from the  
 W still the Ship heading South under  
 Double reefed top sail, full & for sail &  
 min sail still the Capt of the Milton on  
 board at sunset took in the full &  
 for min sail still the Ship  
 heading South Middle part fresh breeze  
 at 7 AM saw a sail at 11 AM spoke the  
 General so ind the Day

 in the Pacific Ocean hunting for Sperm Whales  
 Saturday June the 22<sup>nd</sup> 1867  
 First part in the weather continued &  
 the Milton the Ship heading to the S W  
 at 3 PM double reefed the top sail,  
 at sunset took in the sail all but  
 double reefed min top sail & for sail  
 still in company with 2 Ship Middle  
 & latter part fresh breeze & squalls  
 still in company with the General &  
 Milton the Ship heading S W so ind  
 the Day batt log 28.52 7 AM

Sunday June the 23<sup>rd</sup>  
 First part fresh breeze from the South  
 the Ship heading S W still in  
 company with the General & the  
 Milton at sunset took in the for sail  
 still fresh breeze & squalls Middle part  
 more moderate at Daylight made  
 sail at 10 AM parted from the  
 General & the Milton  
 so ind the Day

Monday June the 24<sup>th</sup>  
 First part steering S W still  
 the 2 Ships insight steering the  
 same at sunset double reefed the  
 top sail & luffed to the wind heading  
 to the S W Middle part fresh breeze &  
 squalls the Ship head from S to S E at  
 Daylight set min sail & full still the  
 General & the Milton  
 were nothing so ind the Day
