 Remarks on board the Ship Home Annel
 Tuesday June the 25th 1867
 First part fresh breeze the Ship
 heading S by E under fore & main
 sails & side for sail & min sail the barometer
 would still insight & the Milton at
 4 pm rose ship to the E at sunset took
 in sail double reefed the fore sails &
 took in the min sail & left the weather
 very cloudy middle part fresh breeze
 at daylight turn the reef out the
 fore sails & set min sail & side the
 Milton still insight saw nothing
 so end the Day 26 27

Wednesday June the 26th
 This day commenced with fresh breeze
 from the E the Ship heading S by E
 in p.m. reefing the min sail the
 Milton still insight at sunset double
 reefed the fore & min sail the Ship
 steering by the wind & set the min sail
 stay sail & spanker middle part
 fresh breeze from the E the Ship heading
 S by E at daylight turn the reef
 out the fore & min sails the Milton
 still insight so end the Day

Thursday June the 27th
 First part fresh breeze from the E
 the Ship heading S by E at 1 pm
 finished the min sail & bent the
 Milton still insight at 3 pm double
 reefed the fore & min sails at sunset
 the weather very cloudy & fresh breeze
 middle part still fresh breeze still
 under double reefed fore sail at 11
 am saw the land of Tongatabu
 the Milton still insight so end the
 Day 28

 in the Pacific ocean leaving for Sheema
 Friday June the 28th 1867
 This day commenced with fresh wind
 from the E the Ship heading from
 S by E to the S by E & very squally
 at 4 pm the land of Tongatabu in
 sight & were ship to the S by E the Milton
 still insight at sunset took in the fore &
 min sail & min sail & side middle part
 fresh wind & very squally took in min sail
 sail & for sail better part still squally
 at daylight below the Milton insight
 at 10 am the fore sail & main
 mast back stay still below sail
 the Day 30

Saturday June the 29th
 This day commenced with fresh
 in p.m. reefing the fore & min sail
 mast back stay at sunset double
 reefed the fore sails & took in the min
 sail the Milton insight at 2 am
 took a light breeze at 6 am saw
 the land of Tongatabu the Milton
 insight the land at 10 am 20
 miles to the S by E the Ship
 steering for the land so end the
 Day

Sunday June the 30th
 This day commenced with fine
 & pleasant weather still steering for
 the land at 1 pm the land
 & Cape to west shore with 2 boats
 at sunset came on board with
 baggage middle & better part
 light weather still laying off on
 at 11 am saw the land of
 Tongatabu still in company with
 Milton so end the Day
