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Remarks on Board the Ship Jane Arnold
Tuesday July the 9th 1867
This day commenced with very fresh
wind still under double reefed top sails
& for sail at sunset took in fore & main
top sails & wore ship to the N.W. Middle
part moon moderate at Daylight set
all sail the ship head to the S.W.
saw Nothing so in the Day 11

Wednesday July the 10th
This day commenced with the very place
at weather the ship heading to the S.
W. with all sail set still in place
on the ship duty at sunset took in
all sail but the double reefed top
sails & for sail still heading to the
S.W. steering by the wind Middle
part calm at Daylight took in light
breeze from the North the ship still
steering to the S.W. saw Nothing
so in the Day

Thursday July the 11th
First part very pleasant weather
the ship steering to the N.W. saw
a fin back at sunset took in sail
all but double reefed top sails &
for sail still steering to the N.W.
the weather very pleasant at 8 pm took
the main top sail still leaving on at
Daylight more moderate & rain squally
latter part took in all sails the wind
blew fresh gale so in the Day
saw porpoises & struck on & lost

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off of Peru Bepord in the Pacific ocean heading for
sperm Whales
Friday July the 12th 1867
First part commenced with moderate gale
still lay true the wind under the double
reefed main top sail & for sail the ship
heading to the N.W. at sunset the weather
more moderate saw Nothing Middle part
the same at 8 pm set for top & main top
sails & the ship & wore ship to the East.
still fresh breeze from the South
so in the Day

Saturday July the 13th
First part fresh wind from the South
the ship heading to the East under double
reefed top sails & for sail & the ship
Nothing at sunset took in fore & main
top sails the ship steering by the
wind Middle & latter part fine light
weather still steering by the wind to
the N.W. saw Nothing so in the Day

Sunday July the 14th
This day commenced with fine pleasant
weather at one pm wore ship to the East
saw a fin back the ship steering by
the wind heading to the E. at sunset took
in all sail but double reefed top sail
& fore sail Middle & latter part fine
weather still heading to the East at 6 pm
set all sail saw Nothing so in the
Day
