

Remark on board the Ship Jane Hendon  
Sunday July the 21<sup>st</sup> 1867

This day commenced with very pleasant  
still employing painting the Boats at  
5 pm finished painting the Boats at  
sunset took in all sail all but the  
double reefed top sail & fore sail  
still heading to the East by the wind  
middle part light weather at daylight  
set all sail & steering N.E. wind & nothing  
so ends the Day

Monday July the 22<sup>nd</sup>

This day commenced with very light weather  
the Ship heading to the East with all sail  
set at 2 pm saw porpoises at sunset took  
in all sail all but double reefed main  
top sail & fore sail & the weather very  
cloudy the Ship still heading to the  
East by the wind middle & latter part  
fine light breeze & pleasant saw a fin  
ck still heading to the East so ends the  
Day

Tuesday July the 23<sup>rd</sup>

First part anchored on main top sail &  
bent another still heading to the East  
with all sail set at sunset took in all  
sail all but double reefed main top  
sail & fore sail still steering by the  
wind to the East middle part still  
fine & pleasant weather at 4 am were ship  
to the South at 6 am set all sail steeri  
ng by the wind saw nothing so ends  
the Day

of New Bedford in the Pacific ocean during the summer  
20  
Whales

Wednesday July the 24<sup>th</sup> 1867

This day commenced with fine & pleasant  
weather still steering to the South by  
the wind at 5 pm saw a sperm whale  
but did not lower for him it being  
too late saw him turn flukes middle  
part fresh breeze at 7 am saw a sperm  
whale at 8 am lowered boats at 9 am  
struck at 11 am took him a long side  
still fresh breeze & very cloudy sat  
ends the Day

Thursday July 25<sup>th</sup>

This day commenced with fresh breeze  
& very cloudy & commenced cutting  
still very fresh breeze & cloudy middle  
raining at 6 am commenced cutting  
still raining & very thick & fresh breeze  
from the North so ends the Day

Friday July the 26<sup>th</sup>

First part still employed cutting  
still raining & fresh wind from the  
North & very thick at 5 pm finished  
cutting still raining took in main top  
sail middle part employed clearing up  
at 7 am commenced hoisting the weather  
very clear & pleasant so ends Day

Saturday July the 27<sup>th</sup>

All this day employed hoisting with  
very pleasant calm weather  
so ends the Day
