

Remarks on Board the Ship Name Samuel  
Saturday October the 5<sup>th</sup> 1867

First part fine & pleasant mainly fin back,  
might in play on the ship's deck, at  
sunset took in all sail all but double  
reefed main top sail & fore sail Middle &  
Satter part the same so ends the Day

Sunday October the 6<sup>th</sup>

First part very cloudy & light rain  
saw many fin back, the ship heading  
North at sunset took in the fore top  
sail & file & were ship to the South  
Middle & Satter part the same  
so ends this Day

Monday October the 7<sup>th</sup>

First part fine light weather  
still mainly fin back insight at  
sunset took in the sail & were  
ship to the North Middle & Satter  
part fine pleasant so ends Day

Tuesday October the 8<sup>th</sup>

this day commenced with light  
winds & clouds, at sunset took  
in all sail all but double reefed  
main top sail & fore sail & were ship  
to the South Middle & Satter part  
rain so ends the Day

Wednesday October the 9<sup>th</sup>

all this 24 hours fine & pleasant  
saw many fin back, the ship  
heading N.W. so ends the Day

of New Bedford in the Pacific ocean

Thursday October the 10<sup>th</sup> 1867

this day commenced with very pleas-  
ant saw many fin back, still head-  
ing N.W. at sunset took in  
all sail all but double reefed  
main top sail & fore sail Middle &  
Satter part strong wind, & thick  
weather so ends the Day

Friday October the 11<sup>th</sup>

all this 24 hours strong wind, & very  
thick saw many fin back, the ship  
heading S.W. under double reefed  
top sails & fore sail & file so ends  
this Day

Saturday October the 12<sup>th</sup>

this day commenced with strong wind  
& thick weather at 2 pm took in  
main top sail still fresh wind  
at sunset took in the fore top  
sail Middle & Satter part fresh  
wind saw nothing so ends this Day

Sunday October the 13<sup>th</sup>

all this 24 hours strong wind, from  
S.W. the ship heading N.W. under  
double reefed top sails &  
fore sail saw nothing so ends the Day

Monday October the 14<sup>th</sup>

First part fresh wind, from S.W.  
the ship heading N.W. at sunset  
took in fore & main top sails Middle  
& Satter part still fresh wind  
so ends the Day
