October the 24th 1867
This day commenced with more moderate
the ship steering N. E. by N under the
double reefed main top sail & fore
sail at sunset huffed to tea the wind
heading W. N. W. by the latter part
still fresh & wind, saw nothing
so ends the Day,

Friday October the 25th
First part more moderate the ship
heading North at sunset took
in the fore & main top sail &
file the weather very cloudy at
Day light light wind made all
sail saw nothing so ends the Day,

Saturday October the 26th
First part fine light weather the
ship heading North with all sail
on saw nothing at sunset took in
the light sails & double reefed the
top sail & took in the jibs
middle & latter part fresh breeze
saw nothing so ends the Day,

Sunday October the 27th
First part fresh breeze from the
West at sunset took in the
fore & main top sail & double
reefed main top sail middle & latter
part light weather saw nothing
so ends the Day,

Monday October the 28th 1867
First part commenced with light wind
& thick fog the ship heading S. E. by E
under main top sail, fore sail & main sail
saw nothing at sunset took in all sail
all but double reefed main top sail &
fore sail still heading S. E. by E the
wind fell part fine pleasant
weather saw nothing so ends the Day,

Tuesday October the 29th
First part fine pleasant weather
the ship heading to the West
at sunset took in all sail all but
double reefed main top sail & fore sail
at Day light made all sail & on bent
main top sail to repair latter part
calm so ends this Day,

Wednesday October the 30th
First part employed repairing the
main top sail still calm at 4 pm
finished repairing the main top sail
& went it at sunset double reefed the
top sail & took in all the light sails
still heading to the West middle
& latter part fresh wind from S. W.
the ship heading N. N. W. so ends the
Day,

Thursday October the 31st
all the 24 hours fresh winds from the
S the ship steering West under
double reefed top sails fore &
main sail saw nothing so ends
the Day,
