

Remarks on Board the same Arnold of
Friday, January the 3rd 1868

this day commenced with fresh wind
& thick the ship heading W by W under
double reefed top sail & fore sail
still fresh wind at sunset took
in the fore & main top sails & set
main try sail middle part still
fresh wind & rain at daylight set
fore & main top sail & trim one reefed
out the main top sail & set main sail
& fil. the ship steering S by E
saw nothing, so ends this Day

Saturday, January the 4th

this day commenced with strong wind
from the N by E at daylight set
ring S by E & set main top galla-
nt sail & flying fil. at 10 pm took
in main top gallant sail & flying
fil. at sunset took in fore & main
top sails main sail & fil. & heaved
to the wind heading South round
double reefed main top sail & fore
sail main try sail & fore top stay sail
middle & latter part still strong
wind, saw nothing, so ends this
Day

Sunday, January the 5th

this day commenced with fresh wind
from the N by E the ship heading
S by E middle part more made
rate at daylight set all sail
saw nothing, so ends this Day

Monday, January the 6th 1868

this day commenced with light wind
from the N by E the ship heading S by
by W the weather very hazy at
sunset took in all light sail & dou-
ble reefed the top sail, & took in the
main sail & wore ship to the S by E
middle part light wind, & very thick
at daylight set all sail still head-
ing S by E & employed on the ship during
the night this Day

Tuesday, January the 7th

this day commenced with very fine light
wind from the N by E the ship head-
ing S by E the weather very cloudy at
sunset took in all sail all but
double reefed main top sail & fore sail
& fore top stay sail & main try sail &
heaved to the wind heading N by E
W by N middle part strong wind, & very
thick at 6 am took in the fore sail
at 7 am set it again still strong wind
at 9 am set double reefed top
sails fil & main sail so ends Day

Wednesday, January the 8th

this day commenced with strong
wind from the N by E the ship heading
W by N at one pm kept off S by E at sun-
set took in all sail all but double
reefed main top sail & fore top stay sail
& main try sail & heaved to the wind
heading N by E middle & latter
part very heavy rain so ends this
Day

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
