Thursday, January the 9th 1868
The day commenced with light
rain the ship heading S by E under
double reefed main top sail at
sunset were ship to the S. W. middle
part very pleasant weather
saw nothing so ends this Day

Friday, January the 10th
this day commenced with very pleas.
ant weather the sail still in
sight at 9 pm spoke the gornalol
the Capt came on board at sunset
took in all sail all but double
reefed main top sail & fore sail the
ship heading S by E the gornalol
still in sight & the Capt & his
wife still on board middle part
fine pleasant weather at Daylight
light squall & fresh breeze set double
reefed fore top sail at 9 am saw
another sail heading to the S. E so ends
this Day

Saturday, January the 11th
the day commenced with fine pleas.
ant weather at 3 pm spoke the
Abraham Barker the Capt came
on board at sunset the Capt & his wife
going on board of the gornalol the Capt
of the Abraham Barker still on board
middle part calm at Daylight
the 2 sails in sight set all sail
but no wind saw no prizes so
ends this Day
Think he means the

of New Bedford in the Pacific Ocean looking
fore sperm whales

Sunday, January the 12th 1868
this day commenced with very light breeze
from the East & very pleasant saw
small fish at sunset took in all
light sail & double reefed the top sail
& hall up the fore sail the ship heading
South the another 2 sail still in sight
middle part the same at Daylight
set all sail & were ship to the S. E
the another 2 sail still in sight
heading to the South saw nothing
so ends this Day

Monday, January the 13th
first part commenced with very
pleasant weather the ship head
South with all sail on the ano
ther 2 sail, out side at sunset
took in all sail all but double
reefed main top sail & fore sail still
heading South the wind still
from the East middle part light
wind at Daylight set fore top
sail & main sail the wind still
from the East saw nothing so ends
this Day

Tuesday, January the 14th
the day commenced with fresh breeze
from the East the ship heading South
under fore top sail, fore & main
sail at sunset took in fore & main top
sail & main sail & set double
reefed main top sail & were ship to the
South middle part fresh breeze at
Daylight set fore top sail, main
sail & fore still heading South
saw nothing so ends this Day
