

Remarks on Board the Ship James Arnold of A. 2nd
Saturday July the 4th 1868

This day commenced with very pleasant weather the ship still steering S. by E. W. the Island of Kytaart, insight A. 2nd sunset past the Island of Kytaart Middle part fine pleasant breeze the ship still steering S. by E. W. A. 2nd & A. 3rd commenced repairing the old main top sail so ends the day,

Sunday July the 5th

This day commenced with very pleasant weather the ship still steering S. by E. W. still employed on the old main top sail A. 2nd sunset the weather A. but the same all this 24 hours fine pleasant winds the ship steering from the S. by E. W. to S. by W. so ends the day,

Monday July the 6th

This day commenced with very pleasant weather the ship steering S. by W. At sunset the weather A. but the same At 4 A.M. steered W. At 8 A.M. saw the land before to the W. S. W. the land to S. W. still heading to the land so ends the day,

Tuesday July the 7th

This day commenced with very pleasant weather the land still insight At 3 P.M. got in into the reef & running down by it At sunset took the sail & stood back, gave water & were ship to the S. E. Middle part heavy squall At Daylight set all sail heading in shore so ends the day

Wednesd in the Pacific Ocean looking for Sperm Whales

Wednesday July the 8th 1868

This day commenced with fresh breeze still laying off on cruising for Sperm Whales At sunset took in the light sail & double reefed the top sails the ship heading N. E. the land a boat 3 miles off all this 24 hours fresh winds set at 11 P.M. saw a sail to the S. W. S. O ends the day

Thursday July the 9th

This day commenced with very strong winds At 5 P.M. spoke the Bark At 10 P.M. the wind very fresh latter part fine pleasant the Bark still insight S. E. ends this day,

Friday July the 10th

This day commenced with very pleasant weather At sunset took in the light sails At double reefed the top sails & were ship to the N. E. Middle part fresh winds At daylight set all top sail, heading down the bay the reef At 10 At were ship to the N. E. so ends this day,

Saturday July the 11th

This day commenced with very pleasant weather At sunset took in the sail all this 24 hours fine pleasant weather still the Bark insight so ends the day
