ends this day

took in the light sails & wore ship to

weather A.T. daylight the Milton
still insight A.T. I Am saw a
Whale A.T. I Am saw all the
boats A.T. I Am stuck so ends the
day

Thursday October the 8th
This day commenced with very pleasant
the Whales still insight A.T. one fin
back the Whales a long side A.T. 4
pm the boats came on board with out
success & commenced butting A.T. 9
pm finished butting & commenced
clearing up middle part fine light
weather A.T. daylight commenced bailing
the Milton out side so ends the day

employed bailing saw nothing so ends
this day
