

Remarks on board the ship James Arnold of
Wednesday February the 10th

First part commenced with moderate
gale & very thick A.T. sunset more
moderate took in the fore & mizen top
sails heading North A.T. midnight
were ship to the S.E. A.T. daylight
set hall top sails saw one sail head-
ing the same A.T. 9 am saw another sail
the weather more moderate but
still thick so ends this day

Thursday February the 11th

First part commenced with mod-
erate still thick 3 sails insight A.T.
took in the main sail A.T. sunset
took in fore & mizen top sail & double
reefed the main still one sail insight
middle part still light breeze 2
sails insight A.T. 8 am saw the 2 sails
whaling it we looked to see the wind
fore the 2 sails A.T. 10 am saw the
Whales lower 3 boats but the
Whales going to first A.T. so ends
this day

Friday February the 12th

First part commenced with very
fine weather the boats A.T. one came on
board with a net success A.T. sunset
the 2 sails insight middle & better
part still fine weather one sail
insight so ends this day

Saturday February the 13th 1869

First part commenced with light
pleasant weather the ship 2 sails heading
N.W. A.T. sunset the Capt off
the Southern light & until 10 pm
middle part still the same A.T. 6
Am sail another sail heading the same
so ends this day

Sunday February the 14th

This day commenced with very cloudy
A.T. one pm saw the French rock A.T.
sunset were ship to the N.W. & took in the
spight sail & double reefed top sails
middle part very calandry & light
winds A.T. daylight set all sail the
2 sails still insight A.T. 8 am commenced
to rain took in the light sails better
part still raining so ends the day

Monday February the 15th

This day commenced with strong
winds & heavy rain A.T. one pm double
reefed top sail & took in the main sail
A.T. 2 pm took in fore & mizen top sails
the Southern light still insight A.T.
sunset close reefed the main top sail
middle & better part moderate gale,
so ends this day

Tuesday February the 16th

First part commenced with fresh gale,
from the South middle part still
fresh winds A.T. daylight & more moderate
set fore sail & sail 3 Whales but
still fresh winds A.T. 9 am the Whales
out side it so ends this day

A.T. 5 pm took in fore sail
