Wednesday, March the 10th 1861

This day commenced with fine
pleasant breeze still employed sailing
at 6 pm spoke the bark Iania the
Capt. came on board at midnight
finished sailing the Iania still in sight
at 8 am the Capt. of the Iania came
on board again so ends this day

Thursday, March 11th

This day commenced with fine
weather still in company with Iania
at 4 pm the Iania went out side
middle & latter part fine light
weather so ends this day

Friday, March the 12th

This day commenced with very
pleasant weather at sunset took in
sail middle & latter part still fine
weather saw nothing so ends this
day

all this 24 hours fine pleasant
weather saw nothing so ends this day

Sunday March the 14th

all this 24 hours fresh breeze from
the S.E. the ship heading E.S.E. saw one sail
steering North so ends this day

of New Bedford in the South Pacific Ocean
for finding dead Whales in 1861

Monday March the 15th

This day commenced with strong wind
from S.E. the ship heading E.S.E. at sunset
double reefed main top sail & took in
the fore sail & wore ship to the S.W.
all this 24 hours fresh wind steering W.S.W.
saw nothing so ends this day

Tuesday March the 16th

This day commenced with moderate
gale from the East at sunset double
reefed main top sail & also reefed fore &
mizen top sails & took in the fore sail
& shifted to head the wind heading South
middle part fresh wind at daylight steered
W.S.W. latter part saw 2 sail heading to the
South so ends this day

Wednesday March the 17th

This day commenced with moderate
gale from the East at 2 pm saw 2 more sails
middle & latter part still fresh
gales so ends this day

still in company
with Papaloon

Thursday March the 18th

This day commenced with fresh
gales 3 sail, in sight middle part
still fresh wind latter part the
same still 3 sail in sight so ends
this day

still in company with Papaloon
