First part fine light breeze the ship
still steering S by S with all sail out
still 3 sails in sight at sunset the weather
a but the same middle part light weather
at day light saw a sail steering S by S
at 10 Am Spark Park Mary Francis the
capt went on board untill 7 pm she 26 days
out from home so ended this day

all this 24 hours fine pleasant weather
the bark still in sight we still steering
S by S with all sail out so ended this
day
