This Day commences with a light breeze from East ship heading to the North latter part calm thus ends this day

This Day commences with a breeze from the West ship steering S.E. saw sperm Whales lowered for them Waist boat missed Starboard boat stuck at 6 P.M. took the whale alongside at daylight commenced cutting at 9 A.M. finished cutting all hands engaged in cutting up blubber thus ends this day

Friday August 27th
This Day commences with a breeze from the N.E. ship heading to the S.E. at 4 P.M. commenced boiling latter part wind South thus ends this day

Saturday August 28th
This Day commences with a breeze from the South ship heading to the West all hands engaged in boiling latter part the same thus ends this day

Sunday August 29th
This Day commences with a breeze from the West ship heading to the North all hands engaged in boiling at 5 P.M. finished boiling latter part steered S.E. thus ends this day

Monday August 30th
This Day commences with a breeze from the N.W. ship heading to the S.W. latter part headed to the North thus ends this day

Tuesday August 31st
This Day commences with a strong breeze from N.W. at 11 P.M. took in the fore top sail latter part rain ship heading S.W. thus ends this day

Wednesday September 1st
This Day commences with a strong breeze from N.E. with rain ship heading S.W. under double reef to ports latter part rain thus ends this day

This Day commences with a breeze from N.W. ship heading N.S.W. latter part engaged in cooping and stowing down Cill thus ends this day

Friday September 3rd
This Day commences with a breeze from the North ship steering S.E. at sunset took in sail at daylight made sail headed S.W. thus ends this day

Saturday September 4th
This Day commences with a light breeze from E.N.E. ship heading North at sunset tacked ship and took in sail latter part a breeze from the North thus ends this day

Sunday September 5th
This Day commences with a strong breeze from the North ship heading N.E. at sunset took in sail latter part squall thus ends this day

Monday September 6th
This Day commences with a strong breeze from N.E. with squalls ship heading S.W. latter part wind S.E. ship heading S.W. thus ends this day

Tuesday September 7th
This Day commences with a strong breeze from S.E. ship heading S.W. at 3 P.M. wind South were ship headed S.E. latter part headed the same thus ends this day

Wednesday September 8th
This Day commences with a strong breeze from the South ship heading to the West latter part the same thus ends this day

Thursday September 9th
This Day commences with a breeze from the South ship heading S.E. latter part squall thus ends this day

Friday September 10th
This Day commences with a breeze from N.W. with rain latter part wind North thus ends this day

Saturday September 11th
This Day commences with a strong breeze from the North with rain squalls ship heading E.N.E. latter part wind N.E. thus ends this day

Sunday September 12th
This Day commences with a breeze from N.E. ship heading S.E. latter part wind E.N.E. thus ends this day
