This Day commences with a light breeze from East at 8 P.M. left Hovos could not ship a Cooper at 1 P.M. tacked to the North thus ends this day

Saturday October 16th

This Day commences with a light breeze from the East ship heading S.E. at 9 P.M. tacked ship at 12 tacked back again latter part ship heading S.E. thus ends this day

Sunday October 17th

This Day commences with a strong breeze from E.S.E. ship under double reef topsails at 7 P.M. close reef the topsails parted jib and Main sail at 11 P.M. parted the foresail latter part blowing a Gale from E.S.E. thus ends this day

Monday October 18th

This Day commences with a Gale from E.S.E. ship hove too under a close reef Main topsail heading N.E. middle part heavy squalls latter part moderate set the topsails double reef thus ends this day

Tuesday October 19th

This Day commences with moderate weather ship heading E.S.E. latter part the same thus ends this day

Wednesday October 20th

This Day commences with moderate weather from S.S.E. Fuzal in sight latter part latter part saw two sail thus ends this day

Thursday October 21st

This Day commences with fine weather wind S.S.W. Fuzal in sight latter part at 4 P.M. saw sperm Whales Larboard boat struck and saved at 9 P.M. took the whale along side thus ends this day

Friday October 22nd

This Day commences with moderate weather all hands engaged in cutting at sunset lashed down at daylight commenced cutting thus ends this day

Saturday October 23rd

This Day commences with fine weather at sunset finished cutting latter part all hands engaged in boiling case and cutting up junk thus ends this day

Sunday October 24th

This Day commences with fine weather wind E.S.E. at 3 P.M. started the try works latter part all hands engaged in boiling thus ends this day

This Day commences with fine weather wind East all hands engaged in boiling latter part the same thus ends this day

Tuesday October 26th

This Day commences with fine weather wind E.S.E. all hands engaged in boiling latter part at 2 P.M. finished boiling thus ends this day

This Day commences with fine weather wind E.S.E. all hands engaged in cooping oil latter part finished thus ends this day

Thursday October 28th

This Day commences with fine weather wind E.S.E. Fuzal in sight bearing S.E. by S ship heading South latter part a strong breeze thus ends this day

Friday October 29th

This Day commences with a strong breeze from S.E. ship under double reef topsails latter part close reef the topsails Fuzal bearing from N.E. to East distance ten miles thus ends this day

Saturday October 30th

This Day commences with a moderate Gale from E.S.E. ship under close reef topsails latter part moderate thus ends this day

Sunday October 31st

This Day commences with a strong breeze from E.S.E. ship * beating up to Fuzal latter part sent a boat on shore thus ends this day

Monday November 1st

This Day commences with fine weather at 2 P.M. landed eight light bls of Oil latter part taying off and at Fuzal thus ends this day

Tuesday November 2nd

This Day commences with a breeze from East at 8 P.M. Cap came on board bringing six seamen with him shared S by W latter part the same thus ends this day

Wednesday November 3rd

This Day commences with a breeze from East ship steering S by W latter part the same thus ends this day

Thursday November 4th

This Day commences with a breeze from East ship steering S by W latter part the same thus ends this day
