This Day Commences with a light breeze from the North ship steering S by W latter part calm thus ends this day

Monday November 8th

This Day Commences with light airs and calms all hands engaged in setting up and fitting riggen latter part calm thus ends this day

Lat 26.20 N Long 25.33 W Tuesday November 9th

This Day Commences with a calm all hands engaged in setting up and fitting riggen latter part the same thus ends this day

Lat 25.36 N Long 25.51 W Wednesday November 10th

This Day Commences with a light breeze from S E ship heading S S W latter part a strong breeze from E S E all hands engaged in fixing riggen thus ends this day

Lat 23.46 N Long 25.25 W Thursday November 11th

This Day Commences with a strong breeze from East ship steering South all hands engaged in fixing riggen thus ends this day

Lat 21.47 N Long 24.45 W Friday November 12th

This Day Commences with a strong breeze from E N E ship steering South latter part rain thus ends this day

Lat 17.51 N Long 23.55 W Saturday November 13th

This Day Commences with a breeze from E N E ship steering South latter part at 8 A M saw the Island of Mayo thus ends this day

Lat 15.07 N Long 23.20 W Sunday November 14th

This Day Commences with a light breeze from N E ship steering S W for port Pray S. Jago in sight at 5 P M luffed to off the port latter part at 9 A M the board boat went on shore thus ends this day

This Day Commences with a light breeze from N E ship laying off and on at Port Pray latter part the same thus ends this day

Tuesday November 16th

This Day Commences with a strong breeze from N E at 5 P M Captain came on board bringing one seaman that he had shipped with him kept away Steered S by W latter part the same thus ends this day

Wednesday November 17th

This Day Commences with a strong breeze from N E ship steering S by W by W latter part the same thus ends this day

Thursday November 18th

This Day Commences with a light breeze from E ship steering S by W at 2 P M took a squall from South at 5 P M heading S W under topsails and courses latter part Squally thus ends this day one man off duty sick

Friday November 19th

This Day Commences with light airs and squalls from East to S E latter part a breeze from N E thus ends this day

Lat 7.29 N Long 24.12 W Saturday November 20th

This Day Commences with a light breeze from East ship steering S by W at 7 P M heavy squalls middle part a steady breeze from E by S latter part squally thus ends this day

Sunday November 21st

This Day Commences with a light breeze from E S E ship steering S by W latter part squally thus ends this day

Monday November 22nd

This Day Commences with light airs and squalls from S E ship heading S S W latter part the same put out a new boat on the West crains thus ends this day

Lat 4.32 N Long 22.29 W Tuesday November 23rd

This Day Commences with a light breeze from South ship heading W S W middle and latter part a strong breeze from S S E thus ends this day

Lat 3.33 N Long 23.17 W Wednesday November 24th

This Day Commences with a strong breeze from S S E ship heading S W latter part the same thus ends this day one man off duty sick
