Monday March 7th
 Sent in a raft of eleven casks starting water and painting
 the outside of the ship latter part sent in another raft of 11 Casks

Tuesday March 8th
 Engaged in filling water, painting ship, and getting off wood
 latter part took off a raft of twenty one casks

Wednesday March 9th
 Engaged in stowing down water, painting ship and getting off wood
 latter part sent in a raft of Eleven casks

Thursday March 10th
 Engaged in painting ship filling water and getting off wood
 latter part the same

Friday March 11th
 Took of a raft of water and two boat loads of wood latter part painted
 the foremast sent in a small raft at and took of two boat loads of wood
