steering S S E

Latitude 21.14 S
Longitude 25.55 W

Monday 14th
all the 24 strong breezes
from E S E steering
S S E on water employed
in ship's duty and so on

Latitude 23.39 S
Longitude 26.11 W

Tuesday 15th
all of these 24 brisk breezes
from E heading S employed
in sundry jobs on the ship

Latitude 25.36 S

Wednesday 16th
this 24 hours commenced
with light breeze from E
steering S S E. Middle part
from moderate later
part fresh breeze

Latitude 27.37 S
Longitude 28.56 W

Thursday 17th

all these 24 hours fresh
breezes from E S E steering
S S E on sail insight bound
to the E

Latitude 29.30 S
Longitude 32.30 W

Friday 18th
first part brisk breeze
from the E S E steering S S E
Spoke the ship's wheel of London
bound to the ship's wheel and
later part light wind

all of this 24 hours
moderate breezes from
S S E steering S E by S

Latitude 32.30 S
Longitude 21.23 W

Sunday 20th

all this 24 hours breeze
breezes E S E steering S E by S

Latitude 33.54

Monday 21st

all these 24 light airs and
calms sighted a shoal of
black fish bored the boats
and haul without success
sighted several finbacks and
and numbers and so on

Tuesday 22nd

all this 24 hours moderate
breezes from S E to S steering
S E by E too sail in sight

Latitude 34.35 S
Longitude 19.20 W

Wednesday January 23rd

all of these 24 hours light
airs from S E steering S E
four sail insight steering
steering S E and so on

Latitude 35.10 S

Thursday 24th

all of these 24 hours
light breeze from
the S steering S E half
E six sail insight
steering to the E

Latitude 35.38 S
Longitude 13.20 W
