

Remarks on board Ship James Edward

Tuesday January 25th 1836

all of these 24 hours brisk breeze from the S^W steering S by E at 3
A.M. sighted the Island of
Tristram Island bearing S distance
25 mile at noon the captain
went on shore and so ends

Saturday 26

all these 24 hours pleasant
breezes from the S all hours
& employed unloading off a raft
of water and 60 bushels of potatoes
ships laying off and on the Island

Sunday 27th

first part pleasant breeze
from S^W at 3 P.M. the raft
came alongside hauled it in
and sent off 256 and commenced
to stow down the water
at 6 P.M. finished stowing down
middle and later brisk
breezes from S^W steering
S by S

Monday 28

first part brisk breeze
from S^W steering S by S
at 1 A.M. the wind hauled
to the N^W middle part
the same and so ends

all of these 24 hours
fresh breezes from the S
heding to the E

Latitude 39.48
Longitude 2.25 W

Wednesday 30th

first part of these
24 hours brisk breeze
from the S heding
to the E middle and later
part heavy rain squalls
and dark and cloudy weather

Thursday 31st

all these 24 hours light
breezes from S^W and cloudy
weather steering S by E
sighted too Humphreys whaler

Latitude 36.30 S
Longitude 2.30 E

Friday February 1st

all this 24 hours variable
winds and cloudy with rain
squalls and so ends

Latitude 36.44 S
Long 4.56 E

Saturday 2nd

all this 24 hours
light airs and cloudy
from S^W steering S by S

Latitude 37.18 S
Longitude 7.24 E

Sunday 3rd

all this 24 hours light
breezes from the S^W
steering S by S

Latitude 37.26 S
Longitude 8.38 E
