

Remarks on board Ship *Saratus Edwards*

Sunday February 18th 1836

all this 24 hours strong breeze from S.W.
showing S.S. and so on.

Monday 25th

First part of this 25 hours commenced with moderate breeze from S.W. storm, & at sundown shortened sail for the night mid-night calm later part fresh breeze from

S.W. showing S

Latitude 44.06 S
Longitude 44.33 E

Tuesday 26th

First part of this 26 hours strong breeze from S.W. showing S by E at sundown shortened sail for the night mid-night heavy rain and fresh gale from S.W. later fresh breeze from S.W. sighted several finches and so on.

Latitude 44.50 S
Longitude 48.45 E

Wednesday 27th

First part fresh breeze from the W. showing S.S. & at sundown shortened sail for the night mid-night pleasant weather later part the same spoke ship with the arrival of new land sighted several right whales. The boats chased with out success at noon came on board and

Latitude 45.00 S
Longitude 49.41 W

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Thursday 28th

First part of this 28 hours commenced with light breeze from the S.W. the boat off chasing whales at sundown the boat came on board with without success later part pleasant breeze at 10 A.M. sighted a whale chased and struck and brought on alongside and commenced getting ready to cut and so on.

Friday 29th

First part of this 29 hours pleasant breeze from W.S.W. all hands employed in cutting at 4 P.M. finished cutting and laid the boat after whales at sundown came on board without success and so on. later part fresh breeze from

Saturday March 1st 1836

First part of this 26 hours strong breeze from S.W. sighted whales chased and chased without success mid-night and later part fresh gale and heavy rain and so on.
