

Remarks on board Ship Lewis & Edmund

Sunday March 9th 1856

First part commenced with a fresh breeze from the S. blowing to the S. by E. spoke the ship North American and ship warning Smith middle and later part light air from the S. at 9 A.M. sighted whales. lowered the boats and chased at 11 A.M. struck a whale which acted very bad and so ends

Monday March 10th

First part brisk breeze from the S. over boat fast to a whale and the whale acting bad - at 5 P.M. cut loose the whale at sundown shortened sail later part strong breeze from the S. to puff to whale and so ends

Tuesday March 11th

First part of this 24 commenced with a fresh gale from the S. clearing S. by E. middle and later part thick fog and so ends

Remarks on board Ship Lewis & Edmund

Wednesday March 12th 1856

First part of these 24 hours commenced with a strong breeze from the S. clearing S. by E. with thick fog middle part the same with double reefed tops later part clear and so ends

*Latitude 44.32 N
Longitude 53.50 E*

Thursday March 13

all this 24 hours strong breeze from the S. clearing S. by E. at sundown double reefed the tops with thick fog all the time and so ends

Friday March 14

all this 24 hours fresh gale and thick fog from the S. clearing S. by E. with heavy rain and so ends
