 all hands employed in repairing
 sails braiding out & stowing of
 between decks at 4 bell strong
 winds from Northward double
 reefed top sails hander light sails

 at 11 still carried away crotchets & cord
 sent it down & found it rotten in the slings
 under double reef variation 27 by Westley
 top sails main course pulled

Friday July 25th
 commences fresh winds from
 N.W. rough sea course E.S.E.
 under double reefed top sails
 main course pulled middle part
 running latter part light
 winds from S.W. stormy by the
