Sey Sept 18th

Begins with light Air
from N.W. and pleasant Ship
steering S.E. & E. Middle part Equally
Latter part the same

Sat Sept 19th

Begins the same Ship
steering the same Middle part strong
Winds Ship steering by the Wind to S
at 20th A.M. saw the Island of St. Thomas
bearing S.W. by S. by Compass Dist 15 Miles
Latter part strong Winds and Equally

Sund Sept 20th

Begins the same Ship
working to windward under all prudent
Sail Middle and Latter parts more
moderate

Mon Sept 21st

Begins the same Ship
working the same Middle part strong
Winds Latter part the same

Tues Sept 22nd

Begins with strong Winds
and Equally Ship steering for Royal
under all prudent Sail at 8th A.M.
got off the Harbor at 11th A.M. Discharged
1455 Gals of Spirit Oil

Wed Sept 23rd

Begins the same Ship
laying off for Royal at 4th Capt came
on Board and stood off there waiting
for a Boatster Joseph Thomas Middle
part strong Winds Ship under Double
Reef Top Sails Latter part the same

Thurs Sept 24th

Begins with strong Winds from
off Shore Ship trying to get into Royal
Harbor Middle part the same at 20th A.M.
got off the Harbor the Capt went on Shore for
the Boatster Latter part Wind and weather
the same

Fry Sept 25th

Begins with light Winds and
pleasant Ship still laying off from at 20th
Capt Smith came on Board and kept off
for Roseau Middle part light Winds and
pleasant Latter part the same

Sat Sept 26th

Begins the same Ship steering
for Roseau at 20th A.M. arrived off Harbor
Capt Smith went on Shore at 4th the Boat
came on Board and the Ship layed off from
the Shore Middle part the same at day light
kept off for the Harbor at 8th A.M. Capt went
on shore at 11th received 91 Bush of Potatoes
Broke out 403 Gals of Water
Sund Sept 27th

Begins with strong Winds from
N.W. and pleasant at 10th Capt Smith came
on Board and kept off S.W. under all
Sail Middle and Latter part the same

Begins the same Ship
steering the same Middle part fresh winds
from N.W. and Equally Latter part
pleasant
