Begins with fresh winds
from S S E and squally ship steering
Bye the wind to S W under all sail
Middle part and Latter part the same

Begins with light winds from
S E and pleasant ship steering S by W
under all sail Middle and Latter part
the same sent down the Main top sail
and repaired it

Middle and Latter part the same sent
down the Main top ballant yard and fished
it broke out 100 lbs of water

Begins the same ship still

Latter parts the same

Begins with light winds
from S E and pleasant ship steering
Bye the wind under all sail Middle
and Latter parts the same sent down
the fore top ballant sail for repairs

of water Middle and Latter parts
