Sund Dec 15th

Begins with strong Winds from S.W. and pleasant Ship steering S & by E at 5⁰⁰ P.M. bent the Top Sail Middle part Specially Leatter part the same

Lat 36. 08 S
Long 18. 56 E

Wednes Dec 16th

Begins the same Ship steering the same Middle and Leatter part the same saw plenty of Sea Ducks

Thurs Dec 17th

Begins with strong Winds from the Westward and pleasant Ship steering S & under all sail Middle part the same Leatter part repaired the fore sail

Fri Dec 18th

Begins the same Ship steering the same at 5⁰⁰ P.M. bent the fore sail Middle part the same Leatter part strong Winds

Lat 38. 11 S

Sat Dec 19th

Begins with pleasant weather Ship steering S & by E under all sail Middle part the same Leatter part the same Broke out 5 or 6als of Water

Lat 39. 56 S
Long 28. 40 E

Sund Dec 20th

Begins with light Winds from S.W. and pleasant Ship steering S & by E Middle part fresh Winds Leatter part strong Winds and Squally

Lat 41. 03 S
Long 31. 56 E

Mon Dec 21st

Begins with pleasant weather Ship steering S & by E Middle and Leatter parts the same

Tues Dec 22nd Wednes 23rd Thurs 24th
& Fri 25th

All of these dates Ship steering S & by E all prudent sail Middle part the same Leatter part the same

Sat Dec 26th

Begins with strong Winds from the Westward spoke the Ship going thence Hog Island Bearing S & by E Compass Dist 10 Miles Middle and Leatter part the same

Sund Dec 27th

Begins with pleasant weather Ship cruising under short sail round Hog Island saw nothing Middle and Leatter part the same

Mon Dec 28th

Begins with fresh Winds from the Eastward Ship cruising about 20 Miles to the Westward of the Island at 4⁰⁰ P.M. strong Winds Ship under Double Reef Main Top Sail Middle and Leatter part thick Fog
