Thurs Jan 7th

Begins with fresh Wind
from the Westward Ship cruising to
the N.W. of the Island Middle part
the same Leather part worked in
Shore

Fri Jan 8th

Begins with strong Winds
from W.W. and smoky at 2 P.M.
spoke Ship Sun Traps Middle
part light Winds and pleasant
Leather part the same Ship working
to the S.W.

Sat Jan 9th

Begins the same Ship
Working to Westward Middle part
the same Leather part strong Wind
at day light saw three Wright Wha
cleared away the Boats and Missed
one to the Starboard Boat Whels
went to Windward Boats came in
Board at 10 A.M. saw three more
cleared away the Boats and Missed
one to the Starboard Boat and came
in Board the Island line by compass
Dist 40 Miles

Lat 45° 30' S
Long 49° 31' E

Sund Jan 10th

Begins the same ship
under short Sail at two P.M. thick
fog took in the Star Sail Middle
and Leather parts the same

Mond Jan 11th

Begins with Strong Winds
from N.W. and blucky Ship cruising under
short Sail saw plenty of Pin Boats Middle
part the same Leather part the same

Tues Jan 12th

Begins the same Ship cruising
on the same ground saw two Wright
Whales going to the Windward gale at
sun set Lowered the Boats with no success
Middle and Leather parts the same

Lat 45° 11' S
Long 49° 40' E

Wednes Jan 13th

Begins with Moderate
Gales and Rising Ship under Double Reef
Main Top Sail Middle and Leather
parts the same

Thurs Jan 14th

Begins the same Ship
Leaving the same Middle part more
Moderate gale Double Reef Star Top
Sail and Jib

Fri Jan 15th

Begins the same Ship
working to Westward under Double Reef
Top Sails Middle part the same
Leather part strong Winds
